



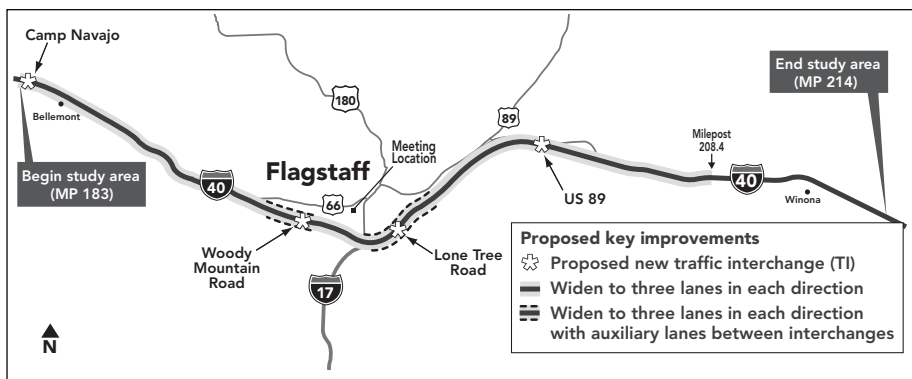

The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT) and the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA), as the lead federal agency, are conducting a study to evaluate alternatives to provide added capacity and improve traffic operations on Interstate 40 (I-40) from Bellefont to Winona. The study area extends along I-40 from mileposts 183 to 214 in Coconino County, Arizona. Proposed alternatives may involve widening I-40, expanding and/or adding traffic interchanges, or maintaining the existing I-40 highway (no build alternative). The build alternatives would likely require new right-of-way.

ADOT and FHWA invite you to attend a public information meeting for this study. The purpose of the meeting is to provide an overview of the study and schedule; present recommendations for roadway widening, new traffic interchanges and improvements to existing traffic interchanges; and discuss existing environmental conditions. In addition, the Arizona Game and Fish Department will provide updated information regarding wildlife movement. This meeting will also provide the opportunity for members of the community to ask questions and provide input. A brief presentation on the study will be made at the meeting, followed by an open house where representatives from the study team will be present to answer questions.
