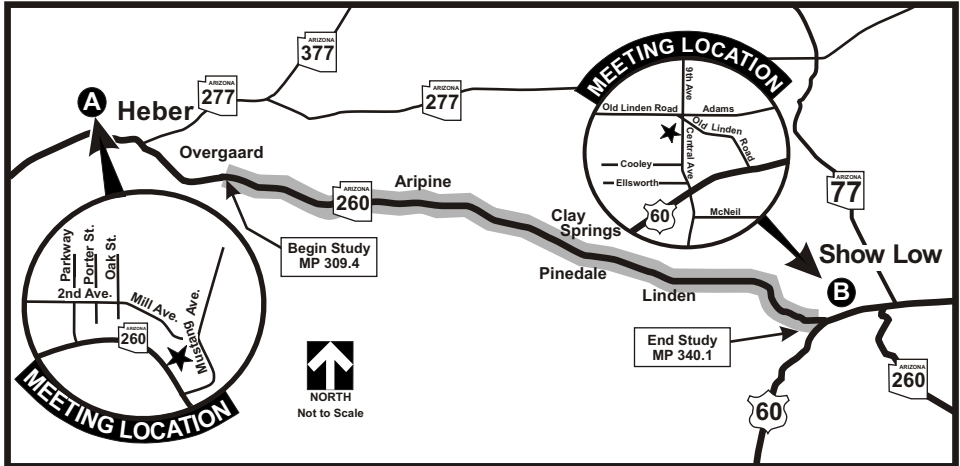

The general public is invited to attend an informational meeting about potential improvements to State Route (SR) 260 between Heber and Show Low. The Arizona Department of Transportation (ADOT), in coordination with the Federal Highway Administration and the Apache-Sitgreaves National Forest, is conducting a study to identify alternatives that would improve traffic flow on SR 260 from Columbia Lane at Milepost (MP) 309.4 to the SR 260/US 60 intersection at MP 340.1. The alternatives, such as constructing additional lanes and consolidating access points in the study area, will be evaluated for potential environmental, social, and economic impacts.

The purpose of the meeting is to discuss the status of the study, present the alternatives under consideration, and gather public input. The comments received from this meeting will be used to help refine and evaluate a preferred alternative. Study team members will be present to answer your questions and address your concerns. Map displays will be available for viewing.
