

Project Summary and Benefits

The Arizona Department of Transportation has begun a erosion control and roadway improvement project on State Route 87. The project is a component of the Maricopa Association of Governments Regional Transportation Plan (RTP), and will be funded by the RTP and the American Recovery and

Reinvestment Act of 2009. The project is designed to improve SR 87 by repairing slopes and ditches, reinforcing embankments, and implementing modifications to meet state and federal standards.

What to Expect

The project will require traffic restrictions on SR 87. After Labor Day (Sept. 6, 2010), northbound SR 87 will be used as a two-way detour during construction on the southbound lanes until Memorial Day 2011.

Around the clock construction activities are expected. Motorists may experience slowing and traffic delays, including short closures. ADOT will provide regular project updates via email and on the project Web site located at www.ValleyFreeways.com.

September 2010 to May 2011 – Traffic restricted to one lane in each direction on SR 87

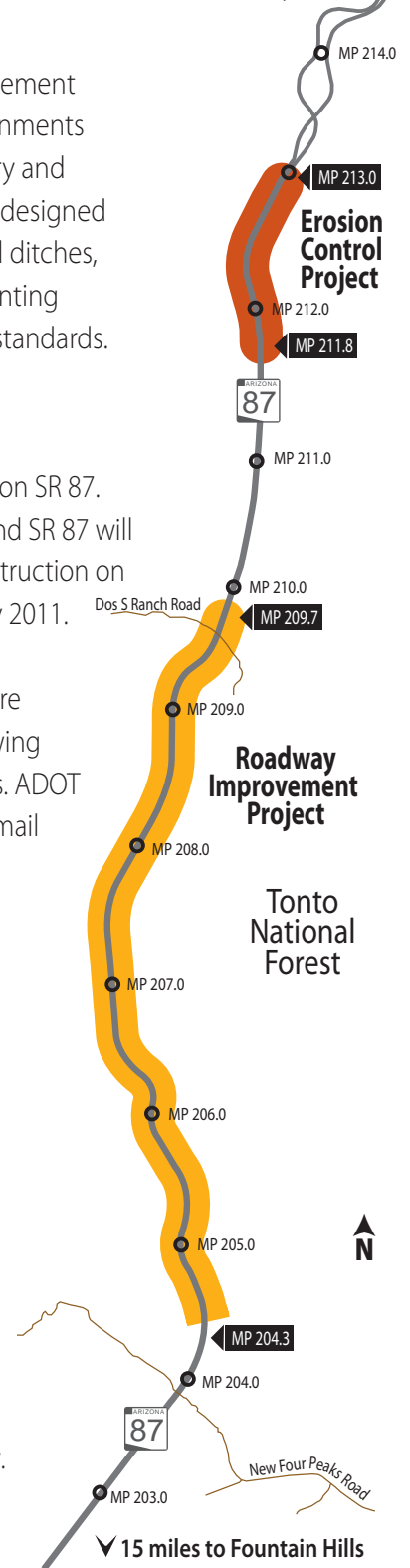
July 2011 – Anticipated completion of construction
